

PRESCRIPTIONS

To avoid errors, please do not order prescriptions by phone and allow 48 hours if collecting and 5 days if enclosing a stamped address envelope. Patient's on repeat prescription systems should see the doctor at regular intervals as arranged by the doctor between 6-12 months for reviewing. Please ask at reception if you wish to know your nearest pharmacy

MINOR AILMENTS SCHEME

It is not always necessary to come to the surgery for minor problems, most pharmacists offer a "Minor Ailments Service". If you speak to your pharmacist they will be able to advise you if they can help you or not, or if you should see the doctor. If you are entitled to free prescriptions, you will not be charged for this service.
